

## HOW TO LOG IN TO OUR NEW WEBSITE - Amended instructions

Click on this link (<http://dyrsaa.massteacher.org>) to launch our new website. This site is open to the public except for specific pages under the “Members” tab which are protected. In order to view the information contained in most of that section, you **must** have a user name and password that you have created on the Massachusetts Teacher Association website BUT you must activate your MTA card first. All of you receive an MTA card every year: many of you put it away and never think of it again. But that little card holds some amazing benefits and they all start by activating your membership number listed on the front. If you’ve never done this, the process is 3-step process starting with activating the card:



Step 1:

Launch [www.massteacher.org/activate](http://www.massteacher.org/activate) - you will come to the following screen:

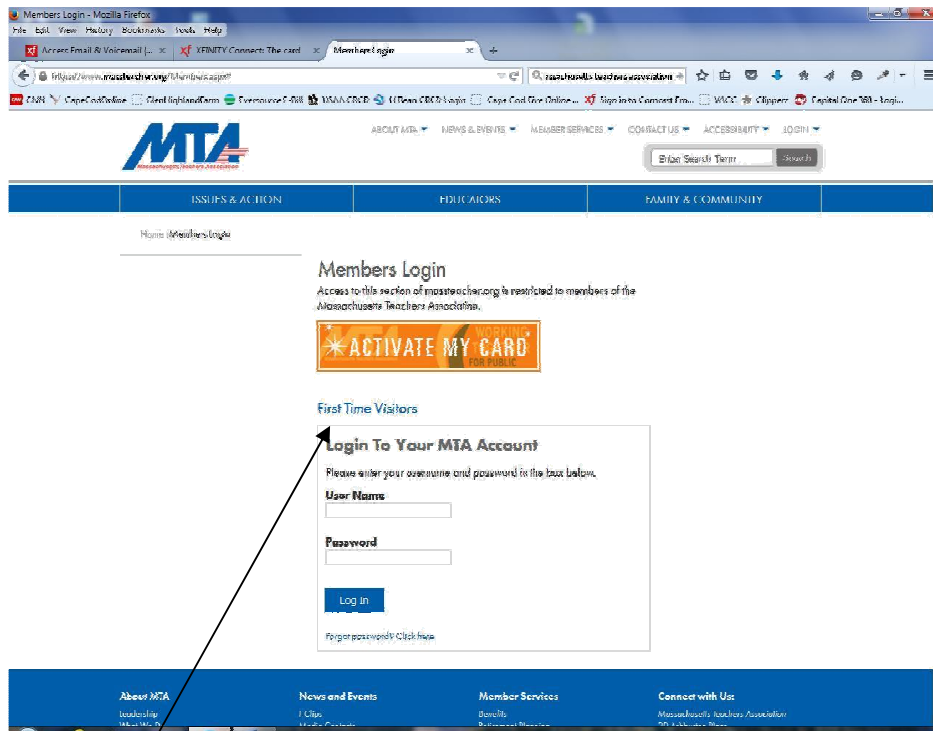

Fill in the two boxes with the requested information. Once that's completed you'll automatically be brought back to this screen:



Step 2:

Click on the **“First Time Visitors.”** The username box is where you type your name (**first name, then a space, then your last name, no middle name or initial**); the second box is where you type your “password” which is your MTA card number without any leading zeros. To be honest, I’m not sure what the purpose of this step is but without it you cannot create your actual login to the MTA or our Association web site.

Step 3:

The last screen is where you create your user name and password logon for both the MTA and our association site. Be sure to use something you can remember however it’s always recommended that you **write your username and password down** as well. Once you have successfully created your UN/PW, go ahead and login to our website <http://dysaa.massteacher.org>. Please take a moment to answer our two question survey posted under the Members tab.

Feel free to explore the Blogs where we post interesting information, newsletters, Judy’s President’s message, upcoming events and more. We also have posted the school calendar and upcoming MTA events and awards. We encourage all of you to login to our member registration section under “Members” and share your contact information with the rest of our membership. We think it’s a great way to connect with one another and keep in touch. If you have questions, complaints, concerns, please submit them under “Need Answers?” Someone from the E-Board will respond to your concern as quickly as possible.

Please send any one of the E-board members, your building rep or me an email (you can find those emails under the Members tab in the *Member Directory*) if you have any ideas about something we should add or if you would like to post something to the site. We’re open to any and all ideas and we’ll get back to you if it can be done. Our goal is to make this a resource of useful information to all of you and we hope you’ll use it often.
